

GENERAL RULES

1. Proprietors of lots acquire simply the right and privilege of burials of the human remains and of construction of vaults or tombs and of erecting monuments and ornaments, subject to the conditions, rules and regulations now in force, or which may be from time to time enacted by the Board of Trustees. The purchase price includes only the right of interment and perpetual care. Lots sold must be paid for when bought. The price and the location of lots for sale may be had from the Custodian.
2. No interment will be permitted or body received unless the proper burial permit is furnished.
3. Subject to the orders of the Trustees, the Custodian shall have care of the Cemetery, and is authorized to enforce the rules, to expel from the grounds any improper person or those who violate the rules, and to refuse admission to any person or materials when he may deem such action necessary.
4. No dogs, or person with fire arms shall be permitted within the grounds, except firing squads at military funerals and public officials.
5. The throwing of rubbish in the roadways or any part of the grounds is **STRICTLY PROHIBITED**.
6. Grave mounds shall not be allowed. No lots shall be raised above the established grade.
7. Trees, shrubs or plants are not permitted. If any plant situated in any lot, shall, in the opinion of the Custodian, become by means of roots or branches, or in any other way detrimental to adjacent lots, alleys, or walks or prejudicial to the general appearance of the grounds, or dangerous or inconvenient to passers, the Custodian shall have the right to enter said lot and remove said plant, or such parts thereof as he may consider detrimental, prejudicial, dangerous or inconvenient.
8. Any breakable receptacles for flowers (plastic or cardboard) being inconsistent with the proper keeping of the grounds are prohibited, and it shall be the duty of the Custodian to remove from the grave, without notice, any of the above-mentioned articles which may be considered objectionable.
9. Planted baskets or urns shall be limited to one per family plot. Urns shall be placed on concrete plates. Planting on lots shall be in authorized containers only.
10. Flowers and plants shall be place to the rear of the monument and not in front of the base line.
11. All monuments or markers shall have a concrete base. No base shall be wider than the grave site and depth cannot exceed five feet.

12. Foundations for all monuments and markers shall have six-inch clearance all around the monument at the expense of the lot owner.
13. The cemetery equipment is permitted to go over any part of the cemetery, and other equipment owned by anyone else may travel only on platted roads except by permission of Custodian.
14. No marker or monument shall be placed or removed without the consent of the Custodian. In the event that general placement rules are not complied with, proper setting of marker or monument will be done at lot owner's expense.
15. The Woodlawn Cemetery shall not be liable for damage or theft to stones, markers or other private property, within the cemetery grounds, due to vandalism, fire, water or any acts of God, military action, contract workers or any other source whatsoever.

RULES CONCERNING INTERMENTS

1. No interment will be permitted without the consent of the owner of the lot, and all interments on lots shall be restricted to the members of the family and the relatives of the proprietors thereof. The Town Clerk must be notified of any transfers of cemetery lots.
2. On the death of the owner, the lot goes to the heirs designated by law. Anyone or more of the heirs may release their interest in a lot to any other heir. The heirs have the same privilege of interring the same persons as have the original owner of the lot.
3. Two (2) interments in one grave **will not be permitted**. Two (2) bodies will be **NOT BE** allowed unless in extreme circumstances.
4. No interments will be done on Sundays or holidays except in case of special necessity or contagious diseases.
5. A marker must be placed on the site within 6 months. Hand digging cremation plots are **ALLOWED** provided they are 18" below grade. (Top of urn must be 18" below).
6. All graves must be marked within the year of death.
7. All interments (except cremations) shall be made in concrete vault. Cremations must be in non-bio gradable containers.
8. The use of tents or other shelter devices at the grave site is **PROHIBITED** except as furnished by and under the supervision of the funeral director.
9. Burials done in winter months are acceptable, although added expenses may be charged at owners' expense due to difficult conditions.

10. All excavations for interments are the **responsibility** of the estates of the deceased owner of plot.
11. **CLEANUP OF THE CEMETERY WILL BE DONE APRIL 1ST AND OCTOBER 1ST WEATHER PERMITTING.**

THESE RULES AND REGULATIONS SUPERSEDES ALL PREVIOUS REGULATIONS
