

Minutes for Town Hall Meeting May 12, 2026

Call to Order at 6:30pm

Pledge of Allegiance

In Attendance: Chairman Neubauer, Treasurer Frisch, Clerk Chambers, Supervisor Niersel, Supervisor Swan, Gene & Susan Williams, Joe & Naomi Welter, Bryon & Kelly Gleisner and Judy Buch.

Motion to approve the minutes from April 21, 2026, Meeting made by Supervisor Swan, 2nd by Supervisor Niersel, motion carried.

Treasurer's Report: As of April 30, 2026. Money Market Account \$66,065.24, General Fund \$26,075.17. Motion to accept made by Chairman Neubauer, 2nd by Supervisor Niersel, motion carried.

Clerk's Report: We were not eligible to receive any funds from Storm Elsa. Eligibility was based on dollars spent and population. Asking for someone to cover Angie's Recycling duties on May 30, 2026, Gene Williams will cover her for that day. Discussion regarding having the recycling open of July 4 and the decision being made to close on the 4th. notice of closure will be posted on the website and at both boxes. Motion to approve made by Supervisor Swan, 2nd by Supervisor Niersel, motion carried.

Road Tour/Inspection Date: Road tour/inspection will be done on June 13, 2026, at 10:am and Supervisor Swan has been assigned to keep notes.

Liquor/Bartender Applications: they have been sent out to Rock Falls Rod & Gun and to Jeb's. Rod & Gun have turned in their applications, so motion was made to approve their application request, motion to approve made by Supervisor Swan, 2nd by Supervisor Niersel, motion carried.

2- & 5-year Road Plan: This discussion will take place after the Road Tour/Inspection and will take place next month.

Metal Recycling Day: Will be June 6, 2026, from 9am until 2pm

Cameras for the Town Hall: Discussion regarding the cameras led to let's put up surveillance signage first then revisit the subject later if problems persist.

Chairman's Report: Only a couple of calls so far since he has taken office, such as weight limit restrictions and a cow in the road.

Public Comment: Per Treasurer Frisch, we are not currently under contract with Darin Pagel so he ***DOES NOT*** have to be the Building Inspector of choice. This will be updated on our website. If you call Lincoln County they will more than likely recommend him so if you or your builder would like to use someone else, then we advise doing your homework to find another inspector if you choose. Judy Buch expressed concerns about Olivotti Lake Road East. Supervisor Swan explained the condition of the culverts, why the size of culvert was used etc. and that the condition would be further evaluated on the Road Tour/Inspection. The decision was made to put the road limit back on indefinitely on Olivotti Lake Road East from JJ to the 51 bypass. Road will be posted for 7 ½ ton limit, this will be updated on the website and will be posed at both boxes. Bryon Gleisner asked whether we had considered his proposal from last month for a petition to Lincoln County to ban Data Centers, Chairman Neubauer explained it would be on next month's agenda we have to create the resolution for our town.
