

Minutes from July 14, 2026, Town Hall Meeting

Call to Order @6:30pm

Pledge of Allegiance

In Attendance: Chairman Neubauer, Treasurer Frisch, Clerk Chambers, Supervisor Niersel, Supervisor Swan, Eugene & Susan Williams, and Bryon & Kelly Gleisner.

Motion to approve the Minutes from June 9, 2026, meeting made by Supervisor Swan, 2nd by Supervisor Niersel, motion carried.

Treasurer's Report: General Fund \$16,005.68, Money Market \$31,140.25. Motion to approve made by Supervisor Swan, 2nd by Chairman Neubauer, motion carried.

Clerk's Report: Partisan Primary Election will be Tuesday, August 11, 2026. Susan Williams will be Chief Inspector for the election, Naomi Welter will be second chair, and Michelle Wienandt will send people into the booth. Clerk will be there to register people to vote if need be and stand in for breaks. The election equipment will be tested on Friday, August 7, 2026, at 5:00pm. Clerk will have in-person absentee hours at the town hall on Saturday July 18, 2026, from 10am until Noon, Saturday July 25, 2026, from 10am until Noon and August 1, 2026, from 10am until Noon. The flyer to register for Lincoln County Alerts is posted on the website and is at the notice boxes and will be available for handout the day of the election. This system is through code red by crisis. Everything is spelled out on the flyer, which alerts you will receive and how to sign up. Chairman's Report: The Lincoln County Highway Department posted a public service announcement on July 14, 2026, regarding the south branch of the Copper River, 0.25 miles west of Forks Road. This road has an **EMERGENCY LOAD POSTING OF 10 TONS**. Structural engineers are working to come up with a solution. Please abide by the posting to minimize the risk of closure to the structure. Road work on 107, they continue to work on culverts, CNN will

be working on the train tracks sooner than expected. Motion to approve made by Chairman Neubauer, 2nd by Supervisor Niersel, motion carried.

Recycling ordinance: As a responsible reporting unit we are required by the DNR to adopt a new recycling ordinance to incorporate changes in the recycling rule revision that went into effect July 1, 2025. Template for the ordinance was provided by the DNR which we used and tailored to our needs based on how we recycle. The new ordinance clearly defines what can and cannot be recycled, resin codes on the bottom of containers and what they mean, days of recycling for our community and puts in place a system of fines for violating the ordinance. Motion to approve Ordinance #07142026-1 made by Chairman Neubauer, 2nd by Supervisor Niersel, motion carried.

There was no Public Comment.

Road Tour observations: Culverts not changing, Gibson and Mary Todd need attention, Abraham also needs work, Mistwood ½ mile needs work, Tug Lake Ave needs Crack Seal, and the 1st and last mile need overlay.
