

Minutes from August 18, 2026, Town Hall Meeting

Call to order at 6:30pm

Pledge of Allegiance

In Attendance: Chairman Neubauer, Treasurer Frisch, Clerk Chambers, Supervisor Niersel, Supervisor Swan, Eugene Williams, Donna Radtke, Elmer Verhasselt, Mike Figley, Joe & Naomi Welter and Bryon & Kelly Gleisner.

Motion to approve July 14, 2026, meeting minutes made by Supervisor Swan, 2nd by Supervisor Niersel, motion carried.

Treasurer's Report: As of July 31, 2026, the General Fund had \$59,162.93 and the Money Market had \$31,153.52. Motion to approve made by Chairman Neubauer, 2nd by Supervisor Niersel, motion carried.

Clerk's Report: of the 488 listed voters in our pollbook, 239 voted, 19 of the 239 were absentee. We also processed 9 Election Day Registrations. On August 10, 2026, I received an email stating that the preliminary estimate of January 1, 2026, population is 630. This represents a change of -5 people. Approximately 523 of the population are of voting age. Motion to approve the Clerk's report made by Chairman Neubauer, 2nd by Supervisor Swan, motion carried.

Chairman's Report:

River Road Property: The Gipple's built a dock, steps and garage on land owned by the Town of Rock Falls & the Town of Merrill. The plow is unable to turn around there, and this is a public entry, and the public is being denied access. Our town and Town of Merrill are working together with the DNR to rectify the situation.

Gibson Dr. & Mary Todd Ct: Cul De Sacs are in very poor condition. Merrill Sand & Gravel will come in to mill & grind one day prior to the work beginning on 107, roughly around the 21st of September. Supervisor Swan is also working to get the new part of Tug Lake Ave crack sealed. He has a quote from Simon Sealcoating for \$2500, but he will also be checking with the county for a quote as well. Motion to approve the chairman's report made by Supervisor Swan, 2nd by Supervisor Niersel, motion carried.

Public Comment: Mike Figley asked for permission from the board to hang a dead-end sign so drivers would know there was no traffic through, the board approved. Elmer Verhasselt wanted to know if we knew when Spectrum would be through laying fiber for the internet on 107. Apparently, Spectrum is working east to west and is currently down on Lincoln Drive, we really don't have a specific timeline for them to complete the work, any questions or concerns should be directed to Spectrum. Donna Radke had a cemetery deed from her father's cousin, and she requested a transfer of the deed to her, the board approved and the transfer was taken care of after the meeting adjourned.
